CANADIANS ARE INVITED TO SHARE THEIR VIEWS ON THE CANADA POST CORPORATION

Ottawa, July 21, 2016 -

The House of Commons Standing Committee on Government Operations and Estimates will be conducting a study of the Canada Post Corporation, and seeks to hear from Canadians on their needs and views on existing Canada Post services. The Committee is also considering recommendations for Canada Post to develop its business lines. The study will result in a report to be presented in the House of Commons in December 2016.

—E-CONSULTATION: The Committee will commence an e-consultation to broaden participation and inform the Committee's study of Canada Post. The e-consultation will consist of an online survey that will be accessible from the Committee website from Monday, September 26 to Friday, October 21, 2016.
